#### CNPA

DH attended the meeting to talk through the preparation for the next Cairngorms Local Development Plan (LDP) and how the Community Action Plan (CAP) will link with this.

DH explained that the LDP update is being worked on currently. More online engagement will be coming shortly and there will also be engagement with the new CAP.

Consultation on suggestions/ideas for the use of land will be asked for around September 2025. This will usually come from landowners but may also involve community councils. DH will be involved in identifying and allocating land.

Relevant Community Councils are statutory consultees on the Cairngorms National Park Local Development Plan. This means they have a right to be consulted on planning applications and must be notified of any amendments to those applications within their area.
